- **Wearable Art with Sarah Shoot:** Join us as we create mixed media brooches using up-cycled fabrics, papers, buttons & more!

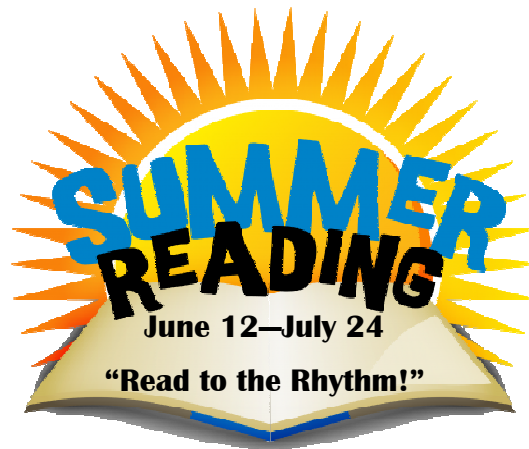

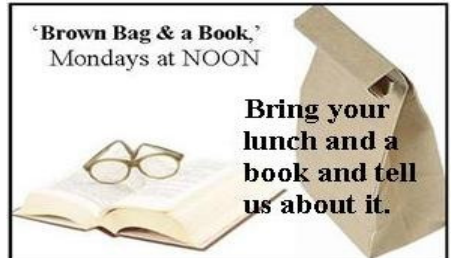
