<b>Outpatient Specialty Mental Health</b> Ext. 55312	Traditional mental health outpatient services including individual, group and marital therapy.
<b>Integrated Mental Health in Primary Care/Behavioral Health Lab</b> Ext. 72382	Provides integrated care for veterans for health and emotional problems; provides services through Behavioral Health Lab (BHL), a phone-based service of assessment and interventions to support treatments for mental health problems initiated by the primary care provider.
<b>Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder Clinic</b> Ext. 59180	Offers individual and group therapy to combat-related Veterans with PTSD. Group therapy options available.
<b>Military Sexual Trauma</b> Ext. 59181 Ext. 72224	Provides free counseling and treatment to veterans for mental and physical health conditions related to experiences of Military Sexual Trauma, even if incident was not reported. Not required to be service connected; may receive benefit even if not eligible for other VA care.
<b>S.A.F.E.</b> Ext. 54759	Class for family members and caregivers of Veterans coping with mental or emotional problems.
<b>Addiction and Substance Use Services</b> Ext. 59167	Provides outpatient treatment to Veteran's experiencing problems with drugs and/or alcohol. Includes individual and group treatment.
<b>Mental Health Intensive Case Management</b> Ext. 59366	Offers intensive case management services; Veterans receive frequent supportive contacts at home and in the community. A "hands on" approach is used to help veterans develop plan of treatment.
<b>Transitional Work Experience</b> Ext. 72438	Offers vocational therapy through work situations in a natural work setting for veterans with a mental health disability. Fosters skills needed to transition to competitive employment. Placements are time limited generally lasting 6 months.
<b>Supported Employment (SE)</b> Ext. 72411	Assists veterans with a Serious Mental Illness gain employment in the community. SE services are not time limited and can last as long as the veteran feels support is needed. When veteran has an open case with SE program, VA Pension will not be affected by income earned.
<b>Family and Loved One Psycho-education</b> Ext. 54759	Trains families to work with mental health professionals as part of overall clinical treatment plan for family members. Provides families with information about mental illness and coping skills that will help them deal with a loved one's psychiatric disorder.
<b>Suicide Prevention Program</b> Ext. 59091	Educates VA staff and community in suicide prevention, partners with community resources to heighten understanding and improve resources to individuals at risk for suicide, and provides monitoring and case management for Veterans determined to be at high risk for suicide.
<b>Health Care for Homeless Veterans Program</b> Ext. 54463	Serves Veterans who are homeless and at-risk. Connects veterans to VA and community-based resources. Maintains a food pantry, personal supply program that provides such items as clothing and hygiene products.
<b>Homeless Veteran Supported Employment Prog.</b> Ext. 59366	Provides vocational assistance, job development and placement, and ongoing supports to improve employment outcomes among homeless Veterans and Veterans at-risk of homelessness.
<b>Housing &amp; Urban Development - Veterans Affairs Supportive Housing</b> Ext. 59366	Joint effort to move Veterans and their families out of homelessness and into permanent housing. HUD provides Housing Choice Voucher Program (Section 8) assistance that allows homeless Veterans to rent privately owned housing. VA offers eligible homeless Veterans clinical and supportive services through its health care system.
<b>Veterans Justice Outreach Program</b> Ext. 72360	Ensures that eligible Veterans in contact with the criminal justice system have access to VA care. Provides education and information to courts/attorneys about Veterans' issues. Provides training to local law enforcement agencies.

<b>Residential Rehab Treatment Program</b> Ext. 59167	Residential facility provides Veteran-centered, evidence-based best-practice treatment in PTSD, serious mental illness (SMI), homelessness, or substance use disorders. Offers short-term and longer-term care, comprehensive rehabilitation.
<b>Psychosocial Rehabilitation &amp; Recovery Center</b> Ext. 59167	Day treatment for Veterans with serious mental illness. Assists Veterans in reestablishing roles within community. Provides access to recovery-oriented interventions and community-based supports that are necessary for living, working, learning, and contributing in their community.
<b>Veteran Peer Support Services</b> Ext. 59091	Veteran Peer support is a system of giving and receiving help founded on key principles of respect, shared responsibility, and mutual agreement of what is helpful; promotes empowerment and self-determination in the service of recovery through peer-to-peer engagement.
<b>Consultation Liaison Team</b> Ext. 55750 Ext. 55511	Provides mental health consultation for Veteran's who are in the Emergency Department, Community Living Center or admitted to the hospital for mental health issues. Makes referrals to appropriate mental health care.
<b>OEF/OIF/OND Program</b> Ext. 54006	Assists newly returning Veterans transition into and coordinate VA healthcare. Case management services available.
