



<u>Tip #1 -</u> How to ask for help.

Ask your student.
Look at the district/school homepage. (This comes up again!)
Call the school. / They usually know in which direction to direct you.



Tip #3 - How to log into your Parent Portal. / (Stay up to date!)

- If you don't have your information, please call the school, they can more than likely provide you your information.
 - Parent Portals show you:
 - ► Attendance
 - ► Grades
 - ▶ A way to email your student's teachers/counselors.
 - Check emails or social media outlets from school for news/announcements.
 - ► Email
 - ► Twitter
 - ► Facebook
 - Youtube
 - ► Instagram

Tip #4 - What are some key words in remote learning?

► Platform

- Google Meets
 - ► What Google Classroom uses to do video chats/classrooms
- Microsoft Meeting
 - What Microsoft Teams uses to do video chats/classrooms
- Zoom Links
 - ▶ What the program Zoom uses to take you to a specific videoconference room.
- Synchronous vs Asynchronous
- Communication
 - Please communicate to your teachers/counselors if your student has a connectivity problem immediately. That same hour if possible via email / phone call to school.

Tip #5 - How to get info on things you don't know.

- Youtube.com
 - ▶ There's a video on anything.
- ► The platform's webpage.
 - Google the platform's support/tutorial page.

Remote Student Troubleshoots

- Make sure your Chromebook is connected to the network.
- Save your work/ Re-start Your Chromebook.
- Try to limit how many things you have connected to your internet at home. (It will slow down your computer to the point in which it will kick you out of meetings or not even let you in.)

<u>Tips for your computer working smoothly.</u>

- Start your computer 20 minutes before your first class.
- Restart your computer after 3 classes of continuous streaming and at the end of the day - shut down.
- Speed test google.com / speed test


Silver lining – Every situation has a silver lining.


