Straight from NASA! Solve the stumpers of space science with solar origami!

Your kit contains a variety of paper types to make all the designs in the ORIGAMI UNIVERSE booklet. Note that different designs recommend different paper types:

- LUCKY STARS = wrapping paper
- SOLAR ARRAY = copy paper
- SPACE TELESCOPE = origami paper
- SUNSHADE = square copy paper

There's also a large, 11x17 template for a starshade.

TIP: Use the protractor from last week as a bone folder, a tool for creasing and folding in papercraft.

MAKE A SQUARE FROM A RECTANGLE:

- Position the paper portrait-style (long way)
- 2. Fold down one top corner to meet the opposite edge, forming a triangle.
- 3. Cut the excess paper below the triangle.


